
Registration Requirements

Registration is REQUIRED. Deadline for registration is the SUNDAY at NOON before your child attends for the week (or when maximum enrollment is reached). This includes registering for all overnights and field trips. A late fee of \$5/child will be charged for all late registrations, when space is available.

Staff are able to be recognized easily by wearing BGCA/FFY attire along with a visible name tag.
