Minimum Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience working with youth
- Loves working with kids
- Must be at least 18 years old
- Current CPR and first aid certifications (any other certifications are a plus)
- Ability to perform duties in a professional and organized manner
- Ability to lead general recreation activities and supervise youth with an emphasis on safety
- Ability to engage youth in a fun and appropriate manner
- Ability to work well as a member of a team
- Ability to operate under and follow the risk management plan
- Need to be available for training which will be announced

Responsible To: Program Director and Program Coordinator

General Responsibility: To lead youth in fun, safe, age appropriate activities and supervise a group at the Club or Camp. To work with youth ages 5-12 from the Columbus area representing its basic cultural and socio economic make-up.

Specific

Responsibilities:

- Safely guide a trail group of campers through the day at Camp
- Work collaboratively with other staff members to create a safe, positive, and fun environment for campers
- Run trail group activities for your group
- Assist the Coordinators in setting up and leading camp activities
- Keep your groups on schedule and arriving at the proper activity locations
- Assist with morning meetings by participating in or leading songs, games, and skits
- Assist with tear down and clean up of activities
- Provide basic first aid to campers and complete the appropriate injury reports
- Other duties as assigned

Essential Functions: Cognitive and communication abilities to make important decisions, plan, and communicate necessary information to campers and staff. Physical ability to be present, lead camp activities, hike the trails, and handle the environmental conditions of camp.
