FOUNDATION FOR YOUTH SPORTS CODE OF CONDUCT

We ask that you pledge to be responsible for your words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in all sports events at Foundation For Youth and shall conform your behavior to the following code of conduct.

- 1. I, and anyone in my party, will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any staff member, coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
- 2. I, and anyone in my party, will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any staff member, coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
- 3. I, and anyone in my party, will not use drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products while at a sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate, or participate in a sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 4. I, and anyone in my party, will not engage in the use of profanity or any other offensive language.
- 5. I, and anyone in my party, will treat any staff member, coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee with respect.
- 6. I, and anyone in my party, will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any staff member, coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
- 7. I, and anyone in my party, will not initiate a fight or scuffle, or retaliate, with any staff member, coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.

Anyone who fails to conform their conduct to the preceding code of conduct while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in a sports event will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- 1. Verbal warning issued by the league or organization.
- 2. Written warning issued by the league or organization.
- 3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a sports event issued by the league or organization.
- 4. Suspension from multiple sports events by the league or organization or by the appropriate official authorized to issue such suspension by the league or organization.
- 5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by the league or organization.
